BYLAW NO. 4-2015

## A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF WALDHEIM TO REGULATE ANIMALS IN THE SAM WENDLAND HERITAGE PARK

The Council of the TOWN of WALDHEIM in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be referenced as "The Sam Wendland Heritage Park Animal Control Bylaw".
- 2. The purpose of the Bylaw is to control and regulate cats, dogs and other pets within the limits of the Sam Wendland Heritage Park;
- 3. No person shall allow their pet(s) to be within the boundaries of the Sam Wendland Heritage Park property. If an owner fails or refuses to comply with the provisions of this section, he/she shall be subject to the penalties as set out in Section 4.
- 4. Penalty
- a. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall receive a warning letter for the first offence, be liable to a fine of \$25.00 for the second offence, \$100 for the third offence and \$500.00 for any subsequent offence.
- b. All infractions after the second and subsequent offences are to be rectified within 30 days.
